Tokyo Metropolitan University (TMU), the only public university in Tokyo, the capital city of Japan, has initiated the original study program "Global City Tokyo Studies." We are seeking applications from Asian students who possess enthusiasm for learning about urban issues in the modern metropolises through study tours and workshops in Tokyo in December 2016. In the program, TMU and students from the Asian Universities (the partner institutions of TMU) will plan for two days of study tours in Tokyo. Through preparation, students from Japan and other Asian countries will discuss and examine the modern urban issues in Asia. They will also practice the tour together in Tokyo to explore and specific agenda items for urban spaces and societies.

The program aims at developing a common understanding about metropolises among Asian students through the study tour. We welcome participants from Asian Universities (limited to the partner institutions of TMU).
